

# A message from Pastor Míchael...

Question: Why Advent? The stores and other public places are playing Christmas carols; Christmas decorations are everywhere; neighbors seem to be frantically outdoing one another with lights and fancy lawn decorations; so why spend is the church taking its time getting into the spirit of Christmas?

These are some good questions that you may or may not have thought about, and they deserve an answer. By its very nature, Advent invites us to slow down from the busyness of the season. This slowing down gives us the opportunity to explore the things that we value most in our lives, as well as where God fits into our priorities.

The most important message we can receive during this Advent season is that God is about to come, not as an angry judge but as a human among us. This is good news upon which to linger and for which we patiently prepare. Allowing the time to pause here in Advent will reap the rewards of patient, thoughtful, prayerful preparation for God's coming among us.

Because of the ongoing Covid 19 crisis, our Advent/Christmas celebrations will not resemble those of past years. We will still worship at 10:00 AM each Sunday, both in the sanctuary and via live streaming. Those of you who wish to attend in person are welcome. We will continue to observe social distancing, wearing masks, and temperature checks. Our live streaming has been a little sporadic as we are getting used to a new video camera and equipment, so please be patient with us as we smooth things out.

We will not be doing midweek worship the same way this year as in the past. We are still determining the best delivery platform (live stream or Zoom), so midweek worship will begin on Wednesday, December 9, and will continue on December 16 and 23. We will give you the details for joining us for these services in an email message prior to December 9.

As I have said to you before, please do not hesitate to call upon me in the event or illness or other needs for pastoral care. I continue to pray for each of you as we navigate these uncertain times. The Lord be with you.


